

**2017 JACQUELINE ARCARIIS  
CIVIL ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIP**

**Background:**

Jacqueline Arcaris spent 12 years in Colorado as a professional civil engineer, focusing on water resources planning, environmental engineering, and project management. Jacqueline was known in the industry for her energetic, supportive and professional leadership. Jacqueline was also actively involved in the American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) throughout her career. She started her involvement at Purdue where she served as the ASCE student chapter president for two years. After relocating to Colorado, Jacqueline continued to be a leader within the ASCE. She helped establish the Colorado Section ASCE Younger Members Group, serving as president of the group and then served as the Colorado Section Treasurer and a Region Governor for the Region 7 Board of Governor's for ASCE. Jacqueline passed away in February of 2012, and this scholarship was created in her honor and in recognition of her contributions to the civil engineering profession and to ASCE. **Eligibility requirements:**

- 1) Any currently enrolled sophomore, junior, senior or graduate civil engineering student in a Colorado ABET-accredited civil engineering program who will be registered as either an undergraduate or graduate student in spring 2017, is a United States citizen, and a member of their ASCE student chapter may apply for this scholarship. Applicant must be a member in good standing at the time of application and award.
- 2) A scholarship may be awarded only to a student who will employ it to continue his/her formal undergraduate or graduate education at a recognized Colorado educational institution.
- 3) Selection is based on participation in ASCE activities (student chapter board member, ASCE sponsored activities – steel bridge, concrete canoe, student conference, etc.), other community activities, essay between 500 and 1,000 words, and one professional recommendation (an academic recommendation from the ASCE faculty advisor, or other civil engineering faculty member, or from an employer or internship employer/supervisor).

**Applications must include:**

- Completed application form.
- Personal essay (500 to 1,000 words) addressing 1) What do you want to accomplish as a civil engineer? 2) How will ASCE help you meet your goals?
- Minimum of one sealed letter of recommendation
- One-page résumé. Include community activities, ASCE activities (including any offices held), and any work experience.

**Procedure:**

One **complete** application package containing one original of all items listed above must be **received** by ASCE Colorado Section by March 17, 2017. **All items must be collected by the applicant and sent to ASCE Colorado Section as one complete application package.** Application packages missing any of the above items will not be considered.

**Award:**

One or more applicants may be selected for award, for an expected minimum of \$2,000 each. Scholarship funds are to be used for tuition, fees and related expenses, and will be disbursed in the 2017 fall term.
